- Include a statement on your activities with AHASC (Youth Club, Showing, etc.).
- Include a picture of yourself, and you only, to be used in our newsletter.
- Include a copy of you AHA Membership Card.
- Include one letter of recommendation, from someone other than a family member.
- List your scholastic achievements, awards, and honors. Please indicate if received in high school or college.

Rules & Regulations

- t. Applicant must currently be a member of AHASC.
- 2. Applicants must sign and date the application to verify its authenticity. Any fraudulent information will be grounds to revoke the award.
- 3. Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent, or they must be expecting to graduate this calendar year.
- 4. The scholarship is awarded to the applicant's school for which they must be used. Upon notification of enrollment, the check will be sent to the recipient in the name of the College or University to which the applicant will be attending. The award is to be used against their educational expenses.
- 5. A pre-selected Scholarship Committee will determine award recipient based on the merit of the applications received. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final.
- 6. All application information will remain in the strictest of confidence by the Scholarship Committee, and all materials received become the property of the AHASC and will not be returned
- 7. A neat and complete application must be turned in with the following:
 - An **OFFICIAL**, **UNOPENED/SEALED**, school transcript from your current institution or your high school if you are currently in high school. If you are not currently taking classes, use the last institution you attended. An OFFICIAL electronic transcript is allowed, e-mailed to bobbarrett@carthlink.net.
 - An essay, 300 words or less, outlining your future goals and bow further education will help you reach those goals.
 - A statement of your activities with AHASC (Youth, Club Shows, etc.).
 - A clear picture of the applicant to be used to announce the scholarship winner in ourJune newsletter.
 - A copy of the applicants *AI* IA membership card.
 - A letter of recommendation from someone other than a family member.
- 8. All completed applications and support materials must be postmarked no later than June 1.
